Community Representatives for the Grenfell Tower Memorial Commission

The purpose of the Grenfell Tower Memorial Commission is to deliver a community consensus for:

- What happens to the Grenfell Tower site in the future, assumed to be a fitting memorial to remember those who lost their lives; and
- How the memorial site will be owned and sustainably managed for the long term.

The role of Community Representatives:

- Represent and input the views of your community group to Commission decisions and other meetings or events.
- Represent the views of the North Kensington area during Commission decisions and consultations to deliver a community consensus.
- Regularly attend meetings and contribute to the Commission's business and feed back information to your community group.
- Lead the Commission's engagement with your community group, ensuring that consultations are open, inclusive and transparent.
- Build and maintain effective working relationships with the Chair, other Commission members, and the Secretariat (the officials supporting the process), to ensure the Commission works effectively to fulfil its remit.

We are looking for:

- <u>Five</u> representatives from the next of kin of those who lost their lives in including parental, partner and sibling relations, or relatives authorised to act on the family's behalf.
- <u>Three</u> representatives from those whose main residence at the time of the tragedy was in Grenfell Tower or Grenfell Walk, and who lost their home.
- Two representatives from those living in the Lancaster West estate.

You will need to:

- Demonstrate you are able to build and maintain the community's trust and respect in order to represent the views of the entire North Kensington area.
- Have strong interpersonal and skills and the ability to build and maintain relationships and work in partnership with others as part of a team.
- Communicate clearly and with confidence to understand and present the views of the community.
- Demonstrate personal integrity, honesty and a high standard of ethics and trust.
- Uphold the reputation of the Commission, standing by and publicly supporting its decisions.
